“THE MENTAL MANAGEMENT OF SITUATION AWARENESS AND DECISION MAKING UNDER STRESS”

Annual reports of the national Firefighter Near-Miss Reporting System have identified situation awareness as the leading factor contributing to firefighter near-miss events. Numerous line-of-duty death investigation reports from NIOSH have also revealed that situation awareness is frequently cited as a factor that contributed to the casualty event. This program will help you understand decision making under stress and how to develop and maintain strong situation awareness.

INSTRUCTOR: Chief Richard B. Gasaway, Ph.D.

Chief Gasaway entered the fire service in 1979 and has served as firefighter paramedic, lieutenant, captain, assistant chief and fire chief in six fire and EMS agencies in West Virginia, Ohio and Minnesota. He is a resident faculty member at the National Fire Academy and is an instructor for the Executive Development Program for the Maryland Fire & Rescue Institute.
